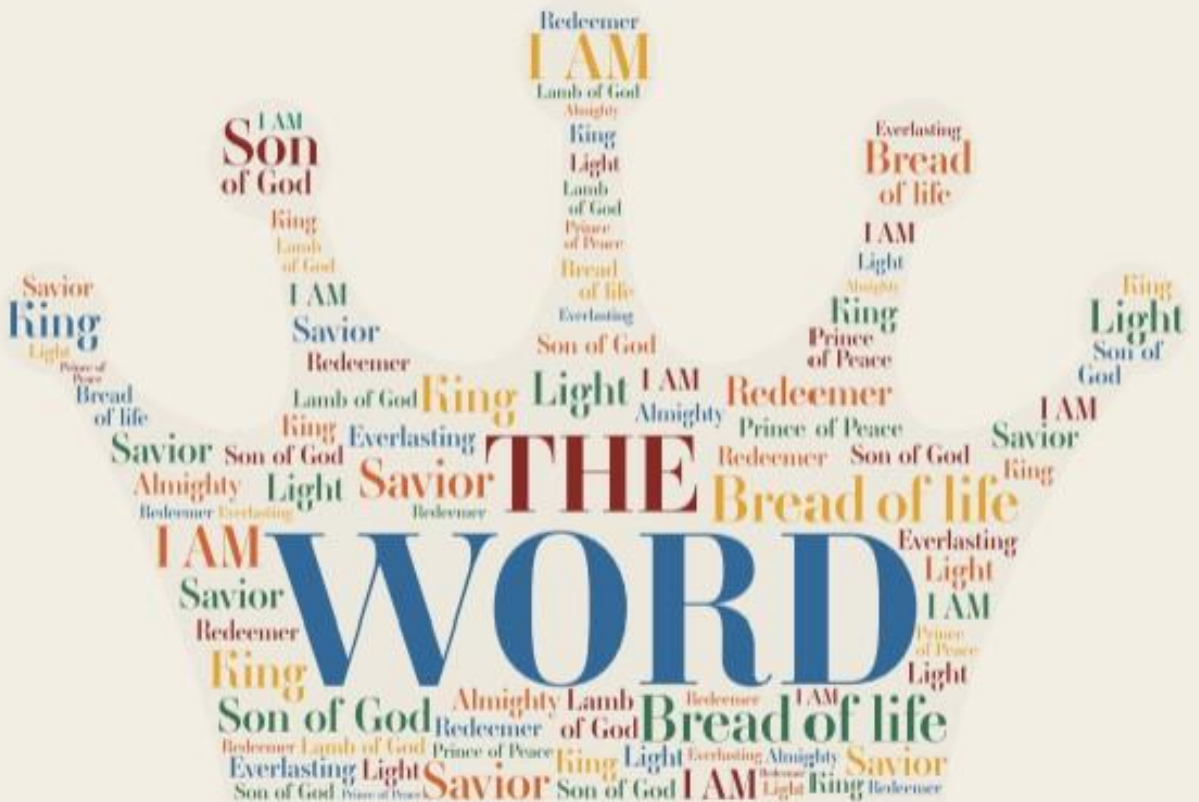
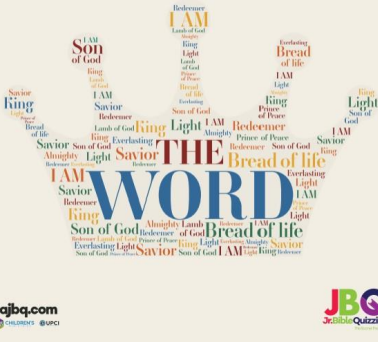


QUESTION KEYS

Junior Set





This is a verse-by-verse breakdown of this year’s material, breaking down the various question types in Junior Bible Quizzing.

Each page will contain the breakdown of all of the various question words within the correlating verse. While this is a very close display of how I write my questions, please understand this is NOT all-inclusive and susceptible to human error. Periodic updates will be submitted to keep these to a minimum.

In certain instances, the question word may encompass a phrase. If there is an additional “what” within the phrase, it will be underlined in the phrase.

Example:

Acts 1:3

To whom also he shewed himself alive after **his passion** by many **infallible proofs**, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of **the things pertaining to the kingdom of God**

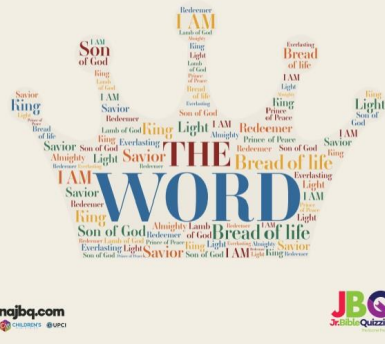
Question: says speaking of what?

Question: things pertaining to what? the kingdom of God.

Therefore, the last phrase is another “what” question, so it is underlined to identify it as such.

Question: the kingdom of whom? This will be highlighted in **Blue** on the next sentence containing the WHO’s located in the verse.

Throughout the study, while the Holy Ghost can be either a WHAT or a WHO, it is highlighted as what it would be written as. When items are highlight in two different colors, it indicates that it is possible that they are written both ways, as some questions may focus on the people, versus whats.

When words are italicized it add one extra breakdown of the phrase.

Question: I perceive what?

Answer: that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity.

Question: thou art in what?

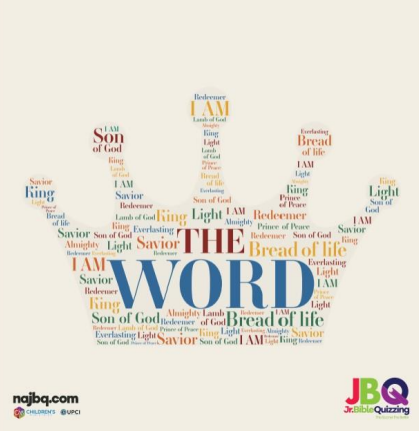
Answer: the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity.

Question: mentions the gall of what?

Answer: bitterness

Question: refers to the bond of what?

Answer: iniquity.



Reintroduction of previous Junior/Beginner questions

A couple of question styles from the past will be reintroduced this year.

10 point questions

Names what person?

this will only be asked if one individual is mentioned by name. Not looking for descriptions of people. I.e. son, man, virgin, angel, etc.

Looking for Proper names.

Names what city?

this will currently ONLY be used in verses that state, “the city of . . .” or is the first or ONLY location given in the verse.

They will not have to figure out the difference between a region, nation, province, etc.

Very straightforward question

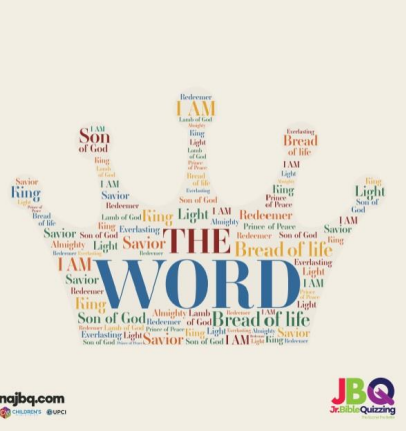
20 point TWO PART question

mentions how many people, and who are they?

This question again is looking for 2 or 3 Proper names in one verse. There is one verse (Luke 2:4) that mentions David twice, this will be counted as ONE person. PLEASE reinforce this point. There are 2 people named, Joseph, and David.

mentions how many geographical locations, and what are they?

This question again is looking for 2 or 3 geographical locations in one verse.
